

CATEGORIES

Commercial

This category recognizes projects that feature wood design in commercial spaces that include offices, restaurants, stores, malls, and industrial buildings. Nominations in this category must use wood as a dominant structural material (walls, floors, and/or roof).

Institutional

This award recognizes the benefits of wood in institutional applications such as hospitals, long-term care facilities, libraries, fire halls, public recreational and library facilities, and school related buildings. Special consideration will be given to projects that utilize wood as the main structural material.

Residential

This category includes residential, single-, and multi-residential building types, apartments, condominiums, duplexes, dormitories, affordable housing facilities, and seniors' residences. Nominations in this category must utilize wood as the dominant structural material.

Special Projects

This category recognizes use of wood in projects such as decks, gazebos, and other unique projects made from wood.

EXCELLENCE IN WOOD DESIGN AWARDS

The Excellence in Wood Design Award was first presented in 1967 and celebrates projects whose design, engineering and construction showcase wood's aesthetic beauty and strength. This award has become a well-recognized symbol of outstanding achievement in project designs using wood and wood products in Texas.

Nominations are open to projects completed in the last five years that aesthetically utilize wood and/or use wood structurally.

To submit a candidate for this award, the nominator should furnish the following items:

- 1) Completed Nomination Form.
- 2) Cover letter supporting the nomination.
- 3) A brief, physical description of the building or project, including a description of the forest products used in construction.
- 4) Digital photos of the project in CD format. Digital photos are preferred and are necessary for equal evaluation of all nominees.

Nominations are due at the TFA Office on or before August 1st of each year. Awards are presented at the Texas Forestry Annual Meeting in October
